## **Important Reminder for Parents: School Supplies**

As we prepare for the upcoming school year, we want to remind you of the essential guidelines regarding school supplies. Ensuring that your child is well-equipped for the classroom is crucial for their success and comfort. Thank you for your cooperation and support in making this school year a successful one!

## **Labeling Personal Items**

Please take a moment to label all personal items, including backpacks, lunch boxes, headphones, shoes, winter clothing, and other supplies. This simple step helps prevent mix-ups and ensures that your child's belongings are easily identifiable.

## **Leave Toys at Home**

We kindly ask that students refrain from bringing toys or items that may be viewed as toys to school. This includes fidget spinners, action figures, “fancy supplies”, and similar items. Keeping the classroom focused on learning helps create a productive environment for all students.

## **Pencils**

Ticonderoga Pencils are superior to other pencils and last much longer than other pencils. They are expensive, but they last much longer and require less sharpening. If possible, please purchase Ticonderogas.



## Headphones

Bluetooth headphones will not work on our devices. Please provide plug-in headphones. Most teachers prefer that students do not have earbuds.

## Supplies:

### Kindergarten:

#### Must Haves for Personal Use:

\*\*Write your child's name on these items.\*\*

- One set of extra clothes in a Ziploc bag labeled with your student's name
- Gym shoes (if your student does not tie their own shoes, these shoes MUST BE velcro closure shoes)
- Backpack (large enough to hold a 12" folder, snow pants, and boots)
- Headphones (no earbuds)
- A water bottle
- Yoga mat

#### Classroom Items:

\*\*NO NAMES on these items.\*\*

- Tissues (any brand)
- Skinny, Fine Tip Expo BLACK dry-erase markers (This brand works best and lasts the longest.)
- Ziploc bags:
  - Girls - snack and quart
  - Boys - gallon and sandwich
- Kids 5" scissors
- Ticonderoga or Dixon brand pencils
- Crayola brand ONLY crayons - 24 count
- Elmer's Disappearing Purple Regular size Glue Sticks
- OPTIONAL - Great Value, Lysol, or Clorox disinfecting wipes

### 1st Grade:

#### Must Haves for Personal Use

- Headphones (no earbuds) (Label with Student Name)
- Gym shoes (if your child does not tie on their own, please send velcro shoes) (Label with Student Name)
- Backpack (large enough to hold a 12" folder, snow pants, and boots) (Label with Student Name)
- Water bottle (that seals)

#### Wish List Items

- 24-pack crayons (Crayola please)
- Fine Tip Expo dry-erase markers (This brand just works best and lasts the longest. Dark colors preferred.)
- Washable markers
- Colored pencils
- Dixon Ticonderoga Pencils (These are the best! They last, sharpen, and erase.)
- Clorox Wipes (or any brand)
- Tissues

## 2nd Grade:

#### Must Haves for Students' Personal Use:

- Headphones (not earbuds or wireless)
- Gym shoes (if your child does not tie on their own, please send velcro)
- Backpack (large enough to hold a 12" folder, snow pants, and boots)
- Plastic water bottle (that seals) - metal ones are noisy and cumbersome.

#### Wish List Items for the Whole Class:

- Dixon Ticonderoga pencils (These are the best! They sharpen & erase well and last a long time.)
- Hand sanitizer
- Tissues

Due to very limited space, ONLY the above items will be permitted in the classroom. All other items will have to stay in backpacks or go back home. Thank you in advance!

## 3rd Grade:

#### **Ms. Green:**

#### Required

- Pencils (no pens will be used in 3rd grade)
- Erasers
- Twistable colored pencils (our pencil sharpeners can't handle colored pencils)
- Pencil case
- Headphones (Label with Student Name) \*the devices we use **DO NOT** support Bluetooth - provide only plug-in type.
- A mouse for Chromebooks (plug-in if possible so we don't have to worry about replacing batteries)
- Water bottle (Label with Student Name)
- Extra change of clothes in a plastic bag to leave in the locker.
- Gym shoes (Label with Student Name)

## Required:

## **Physical Education/Health:**
