IT'S TIME FOR SNOW GEAR

Any student coming in after 8:05 am needs to be accompanied by an adult. This adult can park, come into the office with the child and sign him/her in. It only takes a moment and is part of our safety procedures. The correct "pass" will be given to the child and he/she will be on the way to learning for the day!

REMEMBER THAT...

Students may bring <u>water bottles</u> to school to have throughout the day. We ask that ONLY clear, unflavored water be in these. The students also can fill them up at our clean and fresh filling stations.

It is so important that you keep the <u>office and the</u> <u>clinic updated with working telephone numbers.</u> Keeping the school updated with current address and telephone numbers is a safety issue and we want to be able to reach you should your child become ill or injured. Practicing the address and phone number with your child will also increase his/her safety no matter where he/she might be. We ask that any changes of this sort come to the office in writing.

<u>Shoe tying</u> is a skill that can be fun and easy to practice at home. Please work with your child if he/she is not yet able to tie shoes. If that is the case, please send him/her to school in shoes that he/she can get on and off easily and will be safe moving throughout the hallways on a daily basis.

Any <u>changes to end of the day routines</u> need to come to the office in writing by noon. This too is to ensure all students get safely dismissed. The easiest way is to send a note with your child in the morning. He/she will show the teacher and it then gets turned in to the office so all adults in charge of dismissal are aware of the departure method: pick up or bus.

Please be sure to check your student's <u>Friday</u> <u>Folder</u> each week. Important information comes home in the folders weekly. This is another great way to support home to school communication.

TESTING

In December, students in upper elementary will take the NWEA language test. This is a short assessment, done once a year. Please encourage your child to do his/her best - it is not a race but rather a tool adults at school use to provide the best services to all students!
