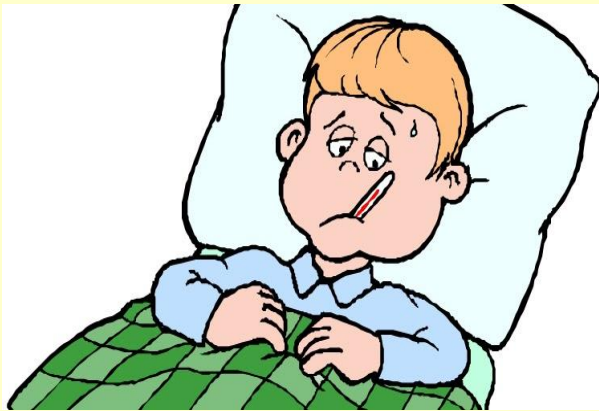

REMINDER

Students must be FEVER FREE for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication in order to return to school.

The Most Recent COVID Guidelines

- **Close contacts of a COVID-19 case do not need to quarantine at home if they:**
 - Had confirmed COVID-19 within the last 90 days
 - Are up to date on all recommended COVID-19 vaccines for which they are eligibleThese contacts should still conduct symptom monitoring and “Mask to Stay” for 10 days from the date of last exposure.
- **Close contacts of a COVID-19 case who do not meet the criteria above need to quarantine or may test to stay and mask to stay. Exposed individuals may:**
 - Home quarantine for days 1-5, if feasible test on day 5, AND “Mask to Stay” for days 6- 10, OR
 - “Test to Stay”* for days 1-6 AND “Mask to Stay” for days 1-10; OR
 - Home quarantine for days 1-10 if unable/unwilling to mask

These quarantine guidelines only apply to exposures that occur in a school setting. Students, teachers, and staff that are a close contact of a COVID-19 case in their household or in the community should follow quarantine guidance for the general public.
