Testing Season

Testing season has arrived! This year Michigan had applied for a waiver from the Federal Government asking for permission to NOT have students do the M-Step. The testing waiver was <u>not</u> granted so Michigan students will be taking the test. They did not take any State assessments last year so this does give them the opportunity to see the tests and build stamina.

In the elementary, students in grades 3 and 4 will take an online MATH and ELA assessment. Students in grade 5 will do an online MATH, ELA, SCIENCE and SOCIAL STUDIES test. These are not available to do remotely, but must be done at school. Our registered face to face students will take the tests the last two weeks of April and into the first week of May.



ALL STUDENTS WILL NEED THEIR OWN HEADPHONES DURING TESTING!

NWEA will be given in May for students in grades K-5. For those families on the virtual option, this IS available to do remotely. Teachers will be sharing information as sessions get scheduled.

Parents can help ease testing jitters at home by:

- *providing reassurance and positive reinforcement
- *ensuring the evening before testing is routine
- *providing time for a good night's sleep
- *starting the morning off calm and positive




REMINDER
